Annual Self Report

NEW Registration Renewal Requirement

What is the Annual Self Report?

The Annual Self Report (ASR) is the first of three components of the College Quality Assurance Program. It is an exciting new practice tool that is online, confidential, and interactive. The Annual Self Report is designed to help you:

1. identify potential risks and supports to competence in practice, and
2. keep current on your professional, legal, and ethical responsibilities as a physical therapist in B.C.

Who has to complete it?

- To renew College registration for 2011 **all registrants** (i.e. full, limited, and interim registrants) must complete the Annual Self Report **by December 31, 2010**.

When is the Annual Self Report available?

- Registrants may access the Annual Self Report online as of September 30, 2010; 7 days/week, at any time.
- The Annual Self Report must be completed by December 31, 2010.

Where do I find it?

- You will receive an email that contains a link to the website and your personal and confidential login, and password. **Please ensure the College has your current email address.**

How long will it take to complete?

- 30 - 60 minutes, according to registrants who participated in the pilot test of the Annual Self Report in July 2010.

The Annual Self Report is confidential; only you see your results. The College will not have access to your individual results.
